The Herbert Protocol is a form.

The form tells the police all about the person with dementia.



The form can be used for people with dementia who:

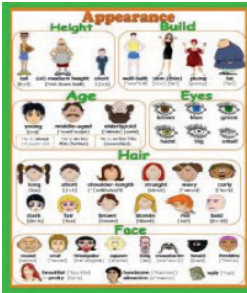
- Live in a care home, or
- Live in their own home, or
- Live with family



Someone who cares for the person with dementia can fill in the form.



The form asks questions about the person.
Things like...



What the person looks like.



Favourite places where the person likes to go.

If they take any medication.



A photograph of them.



If the person goes missing this information will help the police to find them.
