WHY YOU HAVE BEEN REFERRED TO US AND HOW WE CAN HELP YOU

You may have been referred to us because you no longer need acute general hospital care but still require further medical and nursing intervention to assist you further in your rehabilitation and recovery.

You may have been referred by your GP or community health professional to prevent you from being admitted to the acute general hospital. This may involve recovery from an exacerbation of a long term condition or sudden illness.

The community hospitals provide 24 hour care for adult patients and are staffed by a dedicated team of nurses, therapists and health care professionals, working closely with social care teams.

OUR AIM

Our aim is to support you to regain your confidence and mobility by helping you to develop old skills and teaching you new ones. We will agree a rehabilitation programme with you to help you return home or to your usual place of residence as soon as is possible.



WHAT TO EXPECT

Once you are taking part in an agreed rehabilitation programme you will be encouraged to wear daytime clothes and so we ask that it is arranged for you to be supplied with these and necessary toiletries. Please let us know if you will have any difficulties in having your clothes collected to be laundered by family members or carers.

Your rehabilitation will occur on the ward with staff supporting you to regain independence as well as dedicated sessions in our therapy areas as needed.

HOW LONG WILL YOU STAY WITH US?

Part of planning your care with you will involve identifying how long your stay at the community hospital will be. This will be determined by your rehabilitation progress.

We begin to plan your discharge the day you arrive on the unit. The team will identify with you and your family or carers an expected date for you to be able to return home. Please note this is a date we can all aim for to ensure you are prepared for your discharge in a safe and timely way.

If you require on-going health or care support, you may be discharged into the care of our community teams who will continue to support your recovery at home and will continue assessing for any longer term needs.

Should our assessment and intervention advise that you require further support in a social care assessment unit or a longer term placement then these options and processes will be discussed fully with you.

WHICH COMMUNITY HOSPITAL WILL I GO TO?

You will be advised to take the next available bed that suits your needs.

We have dedicated stroke rehabilitation beds at Hazelwood ward and younger people's neurological rehabilitation at Beechwood Unit, both at Isebrook Hospital in Wellingborough.

Some of our community hospital wards also support patients with palliative care needs and we have dedicated specialist palliative care beds at Danetre Hospital in Daventry. If you are referred to us for palliative care we will do our best to support you and your family in a friendly, gentle and peaceful environment. Patients may be admitted because the symptoms of their illness are causing pain and discomfort and we seek to get these symptoms under control as quickly as possible. Thereafter it may then be appropriate to discuss where you would be preferred to be cared for, at home if appropriate, or in a care environment.
