The service provides a 24-hour, confidential helpline for the East Midlands. This is a channel to get the right help for children and young people at the right time.

EMCYPSAS provides medical care and holistic assessment following sexual abuse for children and young people up until they are 18 years old ,up to 24 years of age if a young adult has a learning disability. This provision is in two hubs in the East Midlands, based in Nottingham and Northampton.

Follow-up care will then be offered close to home.
